We have all been saddened by the recent tragic events in Parkland, Florida. As a school community, our thoughts and prayers go out to all the families affected by this horrific act of violence. During these times, we realize that there is a heightened awareness regarding the safety and security of our learning environments.

Therefore, we wanted to assure you that the safety and security of our students, staff, and community members is our highest priority. The Wilson School District has a full-time School Resource Officer, from the Spring Township Police Department, who maintains a consistent presence at our school district on a daily basis. We have recently partnered with our local police department to increase that presence at our buildings. Therefore, if you see a uniformed officer at your student's building, please know they are there to provide an additional level of security for your child.

In addition, we have a comprehensive "All-Hazards Plan." This plan contains specific actions and drills that address an active shooter/ intruder scenario. The plan was developed in concert with law enforcement agencies at the local and federal levels. Our students and staff regularly participate in drills, in conjunction with emergency personnel, to improve our response to potential concerns. We will be enhancing our training in this area to ensure that all of our staff is educated in the most current safety drills and procedures.

Our students, staff and community members play a vital role in helping us maintain a safe school environment. In order to keep our schools secure, it is necessary for students and parents to be aware of, and to take seriously, any potential threats. Please talk to your child and remind him or her to come to a teacher or an administrator with any concerns regarding the safety of our schools.

Our Administrative Team and Board of School Directors will continue to review and strengthen the security measures and procedures currently in place. We greatly appreciate your continued support, as we work together to provide a safe environment for the Wilson School District.
