Grace Austerberry is the daughter of Wilson elementary teacher, Christy Austerberry and her husband Jimmy Austerberry. Last month, at 9 months old, Grace went from being a perfectly healthy, thriving baby to having seizures and being admitted to Hershey Children's Hospital. While there, doctors did all they could to find out the cause of her seizures. Once they exhausted all the resources available at Hershey, they had her transferred to CHOP (Children's Hospital of Philadelphia). It was here that a metabolics team of doctors began seeing Grace and started treating her for a metabolics/mitochondrial disorder. The genetics tests recently came back showing a positive result for a mitochondrial disease called Alper's Syndrome, where there are two POLG mutations. This disease is found in 1 out of 100,000 cases. It is extremely rare. The Austerberry's are putting their faith and trust in the amazing doctors at CHOP and are prepared to do all they can to give Grace the best care.

They are hoping to be discharged from the hospital in the near future. Once at home, their lives will be completely different. We would like to help this loving family to support them in their time of need and help in some of the foreseeable medical costs that will arise.
