



Wilson School District COVID-19 Mitigation Metrics

The following metrics have been developed for the Wilson School District, specifically working and following guidance from PA Department of Education, the PA Department of Health, and our local health experts. These guidelines will be followed until the PA Department of Health provides more direction, or we decide locally they need to be adjusted.

Factors that will be used to transition to a fully remote instructional model as a district*:

- Berks county positivity rate over 10%
- New cases per 100,000 - greater than 100 per 100,000

When one of the two metrics above reach the levels identified over a seven day average, we will transition to a fully remote learning environment for a minimum of 14 calendar days. Currently the county level metrics are updated every Friday, and we will monitor the [metrics](#) working with our local health officials. **We will evaluate the source of any community outbreak and its impact on the Wilson School District.*

Factors that will be used to transition to a fully remote instructional model as a specific building:

If we have 5% of positive cases that can be linked within the same building defined by person, place, and time within 14 days (not living in the same household), we will transition to a remote learning environment for 14 days.

It is the goal of the Wilson School District to provide consistent and transparent communication to our families. Please continue to review our District website for updates and additional information.
