Important Information from the Nurse

In order to prevent the spread of germs, please keep your child home from school if s/he shows any of the following symptoms: unusual skin eruptions/undiagnosed rashes, diarrhea or vomiting, fever over 100.0 degrees, persistent cough or headache, chills, swollen glands, discharge or redness of eyes, or sore throat. Please check your child for signs of illness before sending him/her to school. If your child has been sent home from school due to vomiting, diarrhea, fever of 100.0 degrees or higher or has had a fever (above 100.0 F), vomiting or diarrhea the night before school, please keep your child home from school, the following day to avoid infecting others. A child who is ill will not be able to learn, may infect other children, and will not be happy in school. Your child must be fever-free (without using fever-reducing medications) for 24 hours before returning to school.

Please do not send your child to school with a known illness or injury, an undiagnosed skin rash, or an injury that may require x-ray evaluation, and request that the school nurse examine him/her and prescribe treatment. Only a licensed physician can legally do this function. Parents should keep the child home from school and have him/her evaluated by the physician.
