Happy Spring!

The trees and flowers are in bloom, and allergy season is upon us. Please make sure if your student takes allergy medication for seasonal allergies, you give it before they come to school. We do not administer allergy medication here at school.

Happy to see the sun? So are we, but not the effects it can have on sensitive skin- please apply sunscreen before your student comes to school if they have sensitive skin, provide them a hat for when they are outdoors, and send them with a water bottle. We don't have sunscreen here at school, nor do we apply it.
