This program is one of the largest of its kind. Phi Delta Kappa International and the Phi Delta Kappa Educational Foundation will award thousands of dollars nationally in varying number and amounts in 2019. **In addition, the Kutztown University Chapter of Phi Delta Kappa will award 2 cash scholarships at the local level!**

To be eligible, applicants must be:

- pursuing a career in education; **and**
- enrolled full- or part-time for the fall semester of the application year.

To be considered for the local and international scholarships, please follow these steps:

 - ✓ Click 'Sign Up' and complete the Registration Wizard
2. Complete and submit the Prospective Educator Scholarship application. You will need to create a username and password. Visit the following web address to complete the application:

 - ✓ Read the Scholarship Overview
 - ✓ Click 'Apply Now' near the bottom of the web page
 - ✓ Complete the 'Sign Up' fields
 - ✓ Please note that the Username and Password for this Sign Up are different than the ones created in Step 1.

3. Print the completed application from Step 2. Please ensure that the entire field of each written portion can be viewed.
4. Send a copy of your completed application along with a copy of your a) academic transcript (must include the fall semester and does NOT need to be official), b) reference letter, and c) FAFSA form (only if demonstrating financial need) to the following address:

Completed applications must be submitted (postmarked) to the address listed above by **April 1, 2019**, at the absolute latest. A panel of educators associated with the Kutztown University Chapter of Phi Delta Kappa will evaluate applications and select two outstanding applicants to receive local awards. The international headquarters is responsible for selecting recipients of international awards.

High school seniors who are pursuing a career in education **need not** be planning on attending Kutztown University to apply.
