Dear Senior High School Counselor,

The National Society Daughters of the American Revolution, founded in 1890, is a women's nonprofit, non-political service organization whose mission and objectives are historic preservation, education, and patriotism. NSDAR awards a variety of scholarships through both the NSDAR Scholarship Committee and the PSSDAR State Scholarship Committee.

Last year, the **NSDAR Scholarship Committee** awarded 91 scholarships totaling more than \$277,000. DAR Scholarship Committee manages over 26 scholarships in the following areas: history, political science, government, economics, business, nursing, occupational/physical therapy, medical, law, English, science, math, chemistry, music, elementary and secondary teaching and horticulture.

- DAR's scholarships are awarded and judged without regard to gender, race, color, religion, national origin, or disability.
- Applicants must be citizens of the United States (U.S.).
- Applicants must attend or plan to attend an accredited college or university in the U.S.
- All multi-year scholarships, typically renewable up to four years, must be for consecutive years of attendance.
- Awards are based on academic excellence, commitment to the field of study, and/or financial need, or other restrictions on specific scholarships.
- Awards are placed on deposit with the college or university and any unused portion shall be returned to the NSDAR.
- Students are eligible for one scholarship only from NSDAR.

New for 2019! The NSDAR Scholarship Committee Has an On-line Submission Process

Starting in August 2019, all students applying for scholarships offered by the NSDAR Scholarship Committee will submit their applications using an on-line application process. **Emailed or mailed applications will no longer be accepted.** The DAR Scholarship Committee's direct URL link to the on-line application submission portal is http://dar.academicworks.com. The on-line scholarship portal is also available on Scholarships page on the DAR's public website.

- Scholarship applications for the 2020 academic year will be accepted August 1, 2019 through February 15, 2020 at midnight (Eastern Standard Time). Students will enter and upload all the required scholarship application information using the on-line application process.
- Chapter sponsorship is no longer required. However, DAR members are encouraged to offer assistance to scholarship applicants with their submissions.
- If you are awarded a NSDAR scholarship you will receive an email from the National DAR Scholarship Chairman at the email address you provided in your application by May 15th of the year your application was submitted. Only applicants selected to receive a DAR Scholarship will be notified. You can also check the status of your application by logging into the system at any time.

All scholarship applications must be submitted between August 1, 2019 through February 15, 2020 Midnight EST.

NELSON NURSING SCHOLARSHIP - This scholarship is available to any high school senior residing in Pennsylvania who is graduating from a secondary school that is registered, accredited, approved or licensed through the Pennsylvania Department of Education. The applicant must provide a copy of their acceptance into an accredited nursing program at a hospital or college/university.

MARY REIDER AMERICAN HISTORY SCHOLARSHIP - This scholarship is available to any high school senior residing in Pennsylvania who is graduating from a secondary school that is registered, accredited, approved or licensed through the Pennsylvania Department of Education. The applicant must provide a copy of their acceptance into a course of study in American History at an accredited college/university.

*An affiliation with the DAR is not necessary to qualify for any of these scholarships. Evaluation of all applicants will be made by the State Scholarship Committee who will then notify only recipients by May 15th. Applications will not be returned. Payment of this scholarship will be placed on deposit with the college or university prior to the fall term.

- Completed applications must be postmarked to the local DAR Chapter Regents or Chairs by February 15, 2020.
- <u>Local Pennsylvania DAR Chapters must submit applications to State Scholarship</u> Chairman no later than March 9th.
