# Course Selection Procedure

2020-2021



School Year

- **February:** Counselors will meet in English classes for students in grades 9-11 and to explain course selections.
- **January/February :** HS teacher course recommendations
- **February 1 through 14:** Students can enter course request online via Skyward
- **February 4:** Parent Course Selection Night
- **February/March:** Counselors meet with all students to schedules courses, review credit allocation, and career/future plans.
- **March:** Course verification sheets given to students to take home for parent signature.
- **End of March:** Last day for drop/add

# College Readiness



- **College Bound Students:**
  - It is recommended to take four years of mathematics, science, English, social studies, and a world language.
  - Take at least two Advanced Placement courses and earn a 3 or higher on the exam.
- **Sophomores/Juniors:** PSAT and ASPIRE test administered during the school day. It is recommended that students take the PSAT through the fall of their Junior year to be eligible for National Merit Scholarship.

## Division I and II Academic Eligibility Requirements



1. Graduate from high school
2. Complete 16 core for Div. I. & Div. II.
  - 4 years of English (3 years Division II)
  - 3 years of math ( Algebra I or higher) (2 years Div. II)
  - 2 years of social science
  - 2 years of natural or physical science, including one laboratory science
  - 1 additional course in English/ math/ science (3 for Div. II)
  - 4 additional academic courses
  - Courses completed through credit-by-exam may not be used to satisfy core requirements.
3. Division I – GPA/SAT/ACT (sum) range (sliding scale):
  - 2.3/980/75 - 3.55+/400/37Division II – GPA/SAT/ACT (sum) range (sliding scale):
  - 2.2/920/70 - 3.3+/400/37

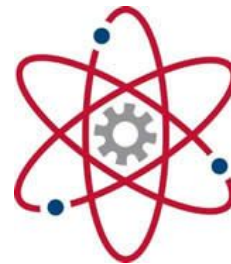
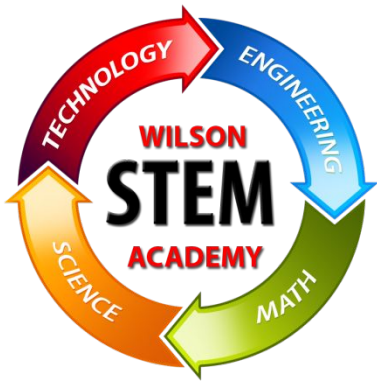

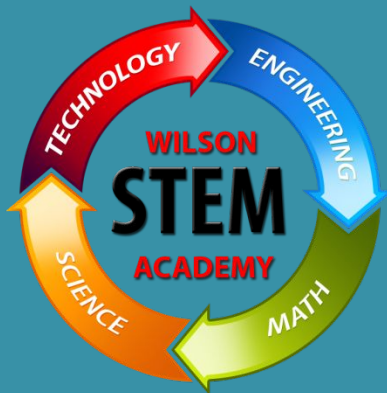

# Open Campus for Juniors



The criteria necessary to apply for open campus is below. **Junior students** that meet **all** of the criteria below will be able to leave school during a study hall.

- **Permission Form** signed by parent/guardian and student.
- **3.40 weighted GPA** and above at end of student's sophomore year
- Extracurricular and/or Co-curricular **participation requirement** or Principal approved activity
- **Minimal incidences of discipline** during Sophomore year
- Student must have **exemplary attendance** during Sophomore year
- Must have **12 credits** completed entering Junior year
- Score of Proficient or Advanced on the Keystone Algebra I, Literature, and Biology assessments
- Student must be scheduled for **5 credits** during Junior year
- Student must sign in and out daily at the greeters desk
- Schedules will not be adjusted to move study halls to certain periods in the school day.
