- English 4.0 credits

  - Math (Alg 1 & Geom required) 3.0 credits

# Course Selection Procedure

## 2021-2022 School Year

- **February:** Counselors will meet in English classes for students in grades 9-11 to explain course selections and the course selection process.
- **January/February :** HS teacher course recommendations
- **February 1 through 14:** Students can enter course request online via Skyward
- **February 4:** Parent Course Selection Night
- **February/March:** Counselors meet with all students to schedules courses, review credit allocation, and career/future plans.
- **March:** Course verification sheets given to students to take home for parent signature.
- **End of March:** Last day for drop/add

# College Readiness



- **College Bound Students:**
  - It is recommended to take four years of mathematics, science, English, social studies, and a world language.
  - Take at least two Advanced Placement courses and earn a 3 or higher on the exam.
- **Sophomores/Juniors:** PSAT and ASPIRE test administered during the school day. It is recommended that students take the PSAT through the fall of their Junior year to be eligible for National Merit Scholarship.

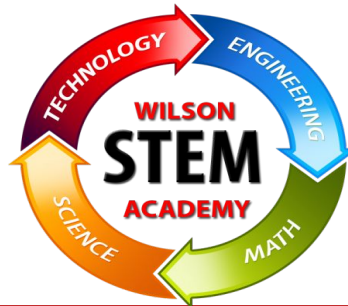

## High School Mathematics

The Requirements:

- **Wilson School District requires three years of Mathematics to be completed prior to graduation.**
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade will count as a math credit towards graduation as long as it is CP Algebra 1, Algebra 1-B, or CP Geometry.



## Do I Need to Take a Math Course?

- Seniors are only **required** to take a Math course if they have not met the 3 credit graduation requirement.
- The choices for classes are determined by the previous course that was successfully completed.
- College-bound students are encouraged to take a math course in their senior year.

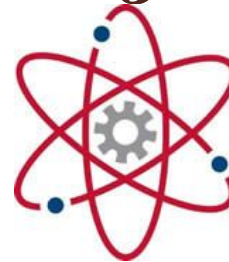
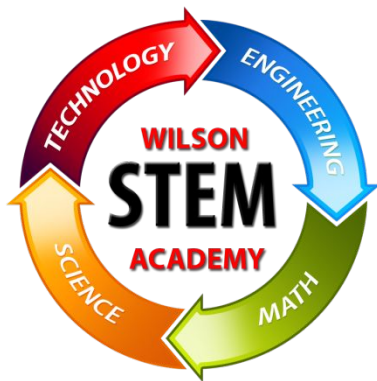

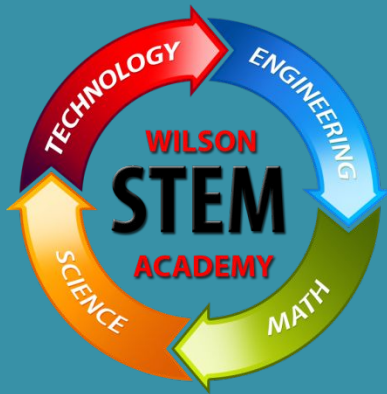
