SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST



We are pleased to announce that we'll be offering two scholarships for the 2022/2023 academic year – one \$3,000 Utility/Partner Company/Association Scholarship and one \$3,000 Pennsylvania Student Scholarship. Applicants can submit a scholarship application for **one** of Utilities Employees Credit Union's (UECU's) scholarships online at uecu.org/scholarship.

Who Can Apply

- Students who will be attending an accredited college/university or technical/trade school in the fall of 2022.

\$3,000 Utility/Partner Company/Association Scholarship

Available to:

- UECU students who have become members by having an eligible family member in the utility/energy industry who works for a UECU partner company (visit uecu.org/partners for a listing)
- Individuals who joined UECU through their own employment at a partner company while pursuing further education

\$3,000 Pennsylvania Student Scholarship

Available to:

- Students who live or attend school in the state of Pennsylvania and have become a UECU member through the Pennsylvania American Consumer Council (PACC). Students can become a member by completing a short membership application online at uecu.org/join. UECU deposits the first \$5 into the student's new share/savings account, and there's no cost to become a member of UECU.



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a UECU member in good standing with a UECU share/savings account in his/her own name (and listed as a primary member) prior to the scholarship submission deadline. Not a member yet? **Join online at uecu.org/join or call 800.288.6423.**
- Applicant must be a high school senior, a college student, a graduate student, or a technical/trade school student.
- Applicant must be attending or accepted at an accredited college/university, or post-secondary technical/trade school. Verification of attendance/acceptance will be required of the winner only.
- Applicant cannot be an employee of UECU, its affiliates, a UECU Board Member, a Supervisory Committee Member, or family member and/or living in the same household thereof.
- Members who've won a scholarship through UECU's Scholarship Contest in the past three years are not eligible to participate in this year's contest.



HOW TO APPLY

Complete steps 1 and 2 by May 23, 2022

Step 1: Go to uecu.org/cueitup and select a 5-minute, interactive e-course from any of the featured CuelUp playlists. After you complete your e-course, make a 2-3 minute video OR write a 1-2 page summary explaining what you learned and how you can apply it to your life. Include a tip that you can share with friends and family based on what you learned.

Step 2: Visit uecu.org/scholarship to access the online scholarship application. Complete the application and upload your entry by the scholarship deadline. (You'll be prompted to upload your entry when you're submitting the application.)

Official UECU Scholarship Contest Submission Requirements

Complete steps 1 and 2 by May 23, 2022.

Step 1: Go to uecu.org/cueitup and select a 5-minute, interactive e-course from any of the featured CueltUp playlists. After you complete your e-course, make a 2-3 minute video OR write a 1-2 page summary explaining what you learned and how you can apply it to your life. Include a tip that you can share with friends and family based on what you learned. Include your name and contact information at the end of your video or written summary. If you are submitting a written summary, don't forget to do a spelling and grammar check. If you submitted an entry in last year's contest, you cannot submit the same entry this year. Please submit a new video or written summary.

Step 2: Visit uecu.org/scholarship to access the online scholarship application. Complete the application and upload your entry by the scholarship deadline. (You'll be prompted to upload your entry when you're submitting the application.)

Prizes: Scholarships are made payable to the college, university, or technical/trade school of choice in the winner's name by August 2022.

Deadline: Completed scholarship applications and video/written submissions must be received by May 23, 2022.

Entry Judging Criteria: Entries will be judged on creativity and content. Get creative and show us your money skills!

Scholarship Award: Two winners will be selected in this year's scholarship contest, and each awarded \$3,000 if they meet the scholarship eligibility requirements.

Winner Notification: The winners will be notified by email and asked for verification of attendance or acceptance at an accredited college, university, or post-secondary technical/trade school. After all information is verified, a check will be distributed to the school of each winner. Scholarship funds may be used to pay tuition expenses while enrolled full time. The winners will be announced on the UECU website and in the October edition of UECU's *Member News*.

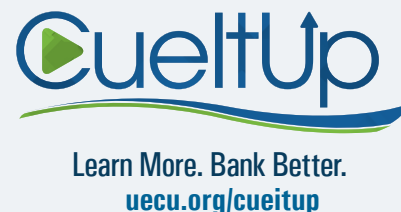
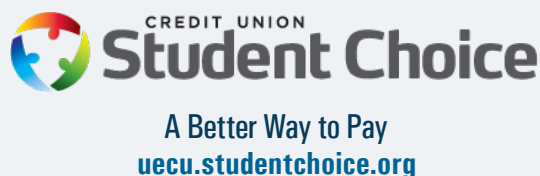
