

2024 Scholarship Application

Pennsylvania Society of Professional Engineers Valley Forge Chapter

The Valley Forge Chapter of PSPE (Pennsylvania Society of Professional Engineers) operates a scholarship program open to high school students who either (1) live in or (2) attend high school in Montgomery County, Berks County or Chester County Pennsylvania and plan to pursue a bachelor of science degree in engineering. Other Chapters of PSPE may also have scholarship programs geared to students in other counties. Applications for the Valley Forge Chapter program are routinely sent to, and may be obtained from, your high school guidance department.

Applicants will be competing for:

- 1. Valley Forge Chapter of Pennsylvania Society of Professional Engineers is providing FOUR (4) one year scholarship of \$1500 to be awarded to outstanding candidates as determined by the Valley Forge Chapter scholarship committee. The scholarship is offered to the top scored applicant that has been accepted to a certified ABET engineering curriculum in the United States of America. Special consideration will be given to Pennsylvania ABET universities. Please check "VFC-PSPE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT" on the application form to be considered for this scholarship.
- 2. Temple University is providing one (1) four-year scholarship of \$2,000 per year (\$8,000 total) to be awarded to an outstanding candidate as determined by the Valley Forge PSPE scholarship committee. Please check "TEMPLE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT" on the application form to be considered for this scholarship. In addition the Valley Forge Chapter offers a \$500 cash award as a 'kick start' the freshman year.
- 3. Qualifying applications will be forwarded to the State PSPE Scholarship Committee for further consideration for scholarships currently being solicited by that Committee.



REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicant must be a citizen of the U.S.
- 2. Applicant must attend a high school in Montgomery County, Berks County or Chester County. Students that are a resident of another county should contact their county's PSPE chapter to determine if similar scholarship programs are available, or call the State PSPE office at 717-236-2050 for more information.
- 3. Applicant must be planning on pursing a degree in engineering.
- 4. Scholarships awarded on behalf of Temple University will be coordinated with other scholarships which are awarded by Temple University or other colleges and are not cumulative.
- 5. The applicant must email the following submittals:
 - a. Personal Information
 - b. College/University Acceptance Letter
 - c. High School Transcript
 - d. SAT/ACT
 - e. Essay on selecting engineering as a profession
 - f. School Activities
 - g. Personal Activities
- 6. Valley Forge Scholarships are awarded to selected applicant who will attend an ABET recognized institution.
