## JUNIOR CLASS OPEN CAMPUS PERMISSION FORM

Junior students will have the opportunity to leave campus with approval from their parent/guardian and administration following submission of the required application. The criteria necessary to apply for open campus is below. Junior students that meet all of the criteria below will be able to leave school during a study hall.

1. Open Campus Permission Form signed by parent/guardian and student
2. 3.40 weighted GPA and above at the end of the student's sophomore year
3. Extracurricular and/or Co-curricular participation requirement or Principal approved activity
4. Minimal disciplinary infractions during Sophomore year
5. Student must have exemplary attendance during Sophomore year
6. Must have 12 credits completed entering Junior year
7. Keystone Algebra I and Literature achievement of Proficiency or Advanced
8. Student must be scheduled for 5 credits during Junior year
9. Schedules will not be adjusted to move study halls to certain periods in the school day
10. When a student with a valid open campus pass leaves school, the school district's responsibility for the student's welfare is waived until the student returns to school.
11. Permission to leave school at open campus time will be revoked by the school authorities for the reported violation of any of the above conditions. Additional disciplinary action may also be taken in accordance with the school's disciplinary regulations.
12. Students must complete and submit the Open Campus Application in June of their Sophomore year to the High School Office. The application will be available during May. A review of the applications will take place in July after GPAs are calculated. Students will be informed of their acceptance via the Skyward schedule feature which is available in mid-August.
