Piano I Syllabus

Course Description:

Piano I is a one-semester course for beginner pianists, dedicated to providing a musically enriching experience for students who wish to keep music in their lives. Students will learn to play piano by ear and from music notation, while studying musical styles and introductory music theory.

Course Objectives:

- Develop healthy playing technique and posture
- Cultivate coordination of left and right hands
- Expand theoretical knowledge of music
- Develop self-evaluation techniques
- Explore stylistic elements

Units of Study:

- 1. Playing by ear
- 2. Introduction to playing from notation
- 3. Staccato v Legato
- 4. C, G, Csus, and F chords
- 5. G position
- 6. Shifting positions
- 7. Beyond 5-finger position
- 8. Scales
- 9. Chord progressions
- 10. Playing in F Major
- 11. Beyond

Musical Expectations:

- By the end of this course, students will be expected to successfully perform at least 4 pieces for memory from units 5 and above.
- By the end of this course, students will have the skillset required to teach themselves new beginner/intermediate piano music.
