TITLE I PARENT AND FAMILY ENGAGEMENT POLICY
2017-18

The Wilson School District's Title I Program is designed and implemented in consultation with parents and teachers of the children being served. The following activities will be conducted annually to insure strong parental involvement in the program's operational procedures.

1. Parents will receive a minimum of two Title I newsletters. These newsletters will include tips to parents about how to promote their child's literacy development, as well as information about the Title I program.
2. Parents will be invited to three meetings in which they will be presented with effective strategies they can use to enhance their child's literacy development. Attendance and agendas will be on file.
3. Each child's parent(s) will be notified via email, phone, or letter (translated as needed) in a timely manner that the child has been selected to participate in Title I with a complete explanation of why the child was selected. The reading specialists will explain the services offered by Title I including specific needs of the child and the instructional techniques that will be utilized to meet these instructional objectives.
4. Title I reading specialists will maintain contact with the parents via email, letter, or phone. They will invite parents to Open House and parent teacher conferences and schedule individual conferences as needed.
5. Title I reading specialists will send leveled texts, additional resources, and teacher made materials home to promote the home school connection. Parents will also be given the opportunity to view demonstration lessons in the Title I and Reading Recovery classroom(s).
6. Our non-English speaking families are included in every phase of our program.
