As snow or other inclement weather situations arise that may affect the school day, Superintendent Richard H. Faidley will be in touch with our Director of Transportation and Director of Operations to make a decision based on the information presented to him for the purposes of maintaining student and employee safety.

This message sets forth the ways in which the Wilson School District will post information related to school closings, delays, and early dismissals for snow or other inclement weather. Please note that communications will encompass both the Wilson School District and Berkshire Heights Early Learning Center notifications.

PHONE (outgoing call)
