

Wilson School District Mask Protocols

- Should a student refuse to wear an [appropriate mask](#) or face covering while they are in the building, the student will be separated from other students and parents will be contacted to pick up the student.
- Refusal to follow requirements of the district Health and Safety Plan constitutes an act of insubordination, which is subject to consequences outlined in the Code of Conduct, published in the Student Handbook.
- Parents picking up students for refusal to wear a mask in the building will be informed that their child will have the opportunity to return to the building the following day and will be required to follow the masking requirement.
- Students are also required to wear a mask to ride the bus. Masks will be readily available on the bus for student use.
- Should a student refuse to wear an appropriate mask or face covering, they will not be permitted to board the bus. Parents would be expected to transport their child to school, where they will be expected to comply with the current masking requirements.
- Students who have a legitimate, documented medical condition or disability that precludes them from complying with the district's masking requirement may provide a medical excuse note from the treating medical provider, which will be reviewed by the administrative team. In some but not all situations, reasonable accommodations may be made through the Chapter 15/504 Accommodations process, or through a revision to the student's current IEP.
